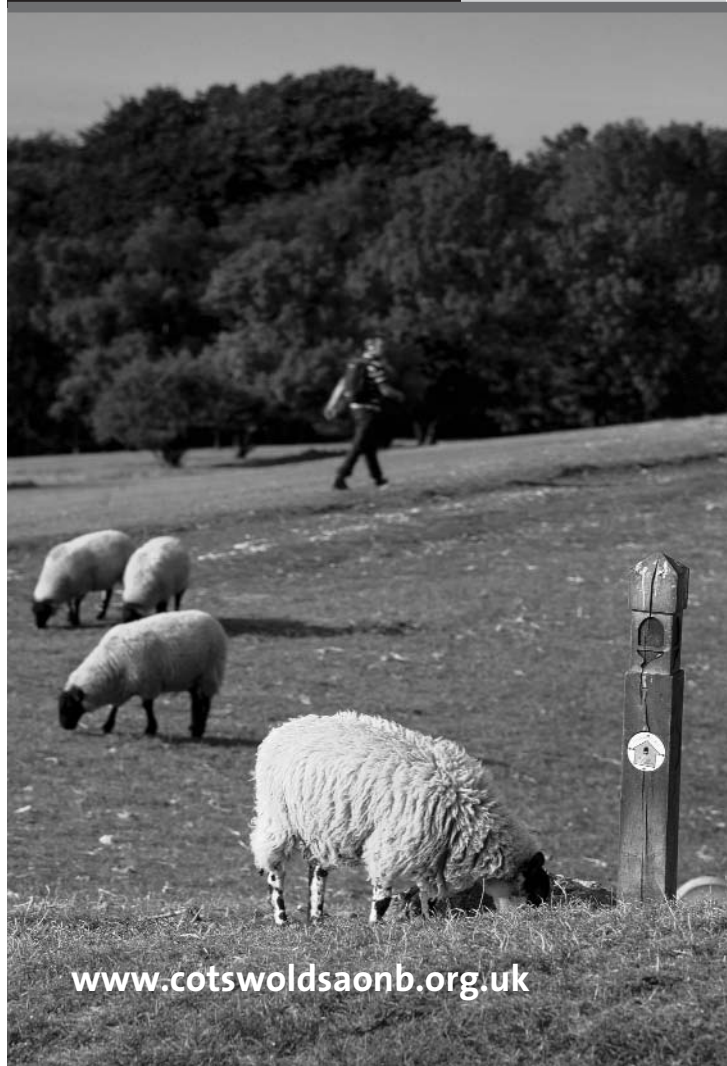

## Explore the Cotswolds by public transport


Most of the Cotswolds is accessible by public transport. This timetable booklet accompanies a colour guide which introduces the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and its attractions together with public transport routes into and around the area. (Find out more about attractions in the Cotswold AONB online by using an interactive map at [www.cotswoldsaonb.org.uk](http://www.cotswoldsaonb.org.uk)).

North, Central and Southern area timetables are available and two editions of each booklet are produced each year: June to December and December to June. There is also a companion booklet telling you how you can walk sections of the Cotswold Way National Trail using public transport to get to your starting point and back at the end of your walk.
